KINDERGARTEN/NVLA OPEN ENROLLMENT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Kindergarten registration for the 2010-2011 school year will begin on **Monday, February 1, 2010, at your neighborhood school. Check with your neighborhood school for specific registration hours.** Children must be 5 years old on or before December 2, 2010 in order to qualify for kindergarten.

Parents will need to bring proof of their child's birthdate, immunization records, social security number (optional) and two documents verifying your address (i.e., P.G. & E., water, phone, cable, rental agreement, etc.).

Immunization requirements for kindergarten entrants include : 3 doses of hepatitis B vaccine, 4 doses of polio or 3 doses if one dose was given after the 4th birthday, 5 doses of DPT or 4 doses if one dose was given after the 4th birthday, two doses of Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR), a Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccination or health care provider-documented Varicella disease or immunity, before entering school.

If you have any questions regarding your child's immunization record, please contact your physician or the Napa County Health Department. The Napa County Immunization Clinic is held every Tuesday, 1:00-5:30 p.m. and every Thursday, 1:00 – 4:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary and there is no charge for school required immunizations. The Napa County Health Department is located at 2344 Old Sonoma Rd., Building G, Napa. Their telephone number is (707) 253-4270.

Many neighborhood schools are expected to fill to capacity quickly, so parents are urged to register their children Beginning February 1st, 2010. Once a school is full, additional children may have to be sent to other schools where space is available.

To verify your school of residence please contact your neighborhood school.

Specific procedures for kindergarten enrollment/open enrollment at NVLA are the following:

- Consistent with past practice and the NVLA Charter, Registration and Open Enrollment forms will be available and may be filled out at NVLA during February.
- Parents wishing to apply to NVLA may do so at NVLA and do not need to register at their resident school.
- NVLA is the only exception wherein parents may submit their open enrollment forms in February and must be received no later than February 26, 2010 in order to participate in the lottery. NVLA's open enrollment forms will be held until open enrollment procedures are either conducted in April or further clarified for NVLA only.

All students retain the right to attend their resident school if their open enrollment application is not accepted to attend another school.

Open Enrollment for all other elementary students, including kindergarten students, will be conducted March 1st – March 26th this year.
